

What is the Covenant?

Merriam-Webster

1. a usually formal, solemn, and binding agreement
2. a written agreement or promise usually under seal between two or more parties especially for the performance of some action

“A relationship between God (Yahweh) and the people of Israel, including two components: God’s promise to be with the people (evidenced by God’s prior actions on their behalf) and the people’s obligation to serve and obey God.” –
