Standing, standing, Standing on the promises of God, my Savior; Standing, standing, I'm standing on the promises of God.

Promise (n)

- 1. a : declaration that one will do or refrain from doing something specified
 - b : a legally binding declaration that gives the person to whom it is made a right to expect or to claim the performance or forbearance of a specified act
- 2 : reason to expect something *Merriam-Webster*

The word "promise" appears rarely in the Gospels

Not always in a good way: Matt. 14: 7 (p. 1520); Mark 14:11 (p. 1579) Concerning the promise of a Messiah: Luke 2:29 (p. 1592) The Holy Spirit: Luke 24:49 (p. 1644)

Used extensively in the rest of the NT

What promises did God make in the text of the Bible?

#410 Standing on the Promises

5 Standing on the promises I cannot fall, List'ning every moment to the Spirit's call, Resting in my Savior as my All in All, Standing on the promises of God. [Refrain]
